Nutrient pollution is a form of water pollution caused by too much nitrogen and phosphorus in the air and water. Nutrients are chemical elements all living organisms need to grow





These excess nutrients increase the growth of algae and lead to eutrophication



Water pollution is the contamination of water bodies like lakes, rivers, oceans, and groundwater. It occurs when pollutants are discharged directly or indirectly into water bodies without enough treatment to get rid of harmful compounds.
